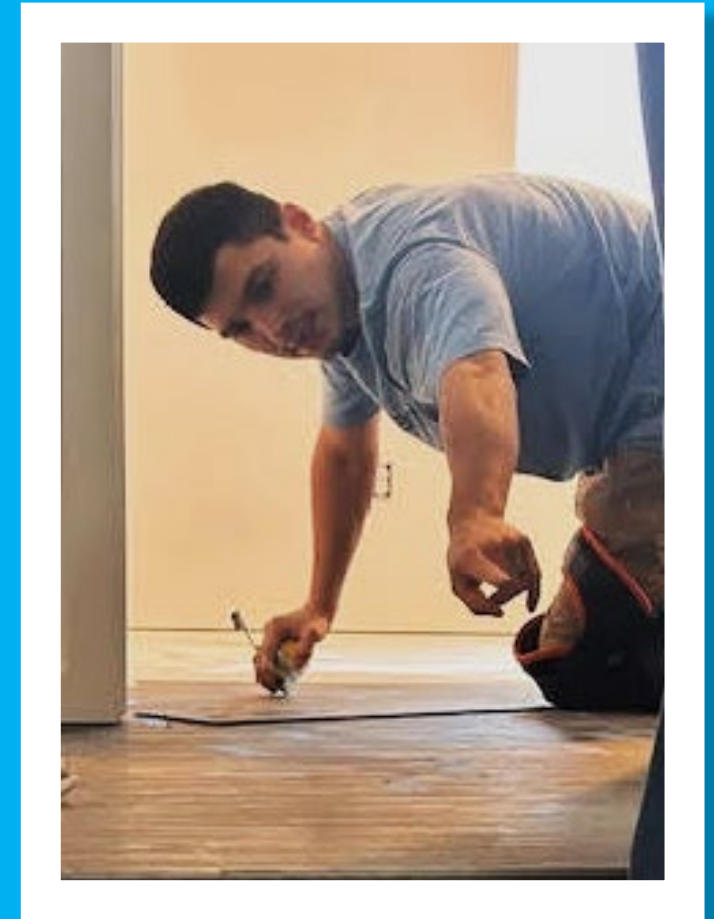
THE FOUNDATION

A Habitat-Spokane home not only provides a strong foundation for low - to moderate-income families to stand on their own, but it also produces a ripple effect that revitalizes our neighborhoods by raising property values and supporting surrounding businesses.

VOLUNTEERS & COMMUNITY

Who volunteers? – community members, businesses, other non-profits, small groups (like ours), future homeowner, must be 16 years or older to volunteer.

Why they matter. – Volunteering helps keep the cost of the project down. This allows Habitat to sell the house to the new owners at the cost of construct which is typically \$100,000 less than market value.

QUALIFICATIONS

All future Habitat-Spokane homeowners are modest-income families who are accepted based on their readiness to maintain an affordable mortgage and the willingness to invest time into building their own homes.

We walk alongside each family on their journey with unique homeownership classes such as budgeting, insurance, legal issues, home maintenance, and more.

IMPACT

Global Impact

- Over 800,000 homes built
- 59 million people by getting them into newly constructed or repaired homes.

Local Impact

- Large need for affordable housing as there are now over 3,000 people on the waitlist.
- 215 homes built in 25 years (10 Energy Efficient Homes in 2024)
- Nearly 400 families helped

Neighborhood Revitalizations

- Helped 9.5 million people with housing improvement through training programs and advocacy work.

Ongoing Impacts in the Spokane Area

- 70 to 80 Homes Planned in Airway Heights, WA (Highland Village)
- Completion of the Hope Meadows Development

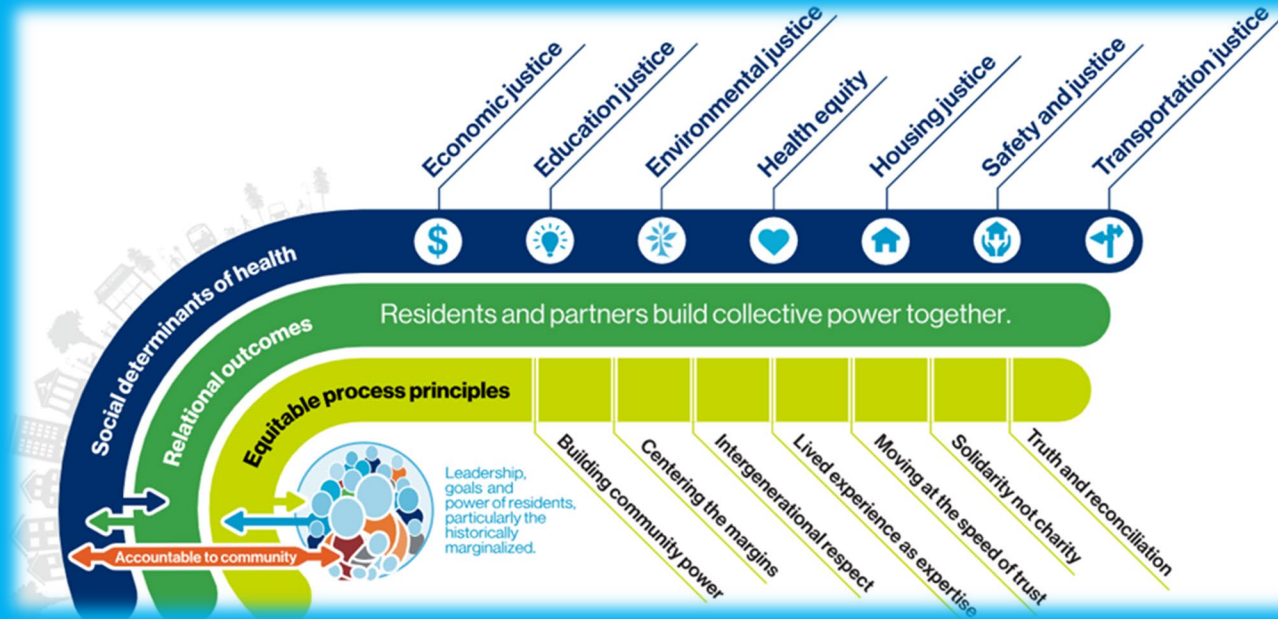

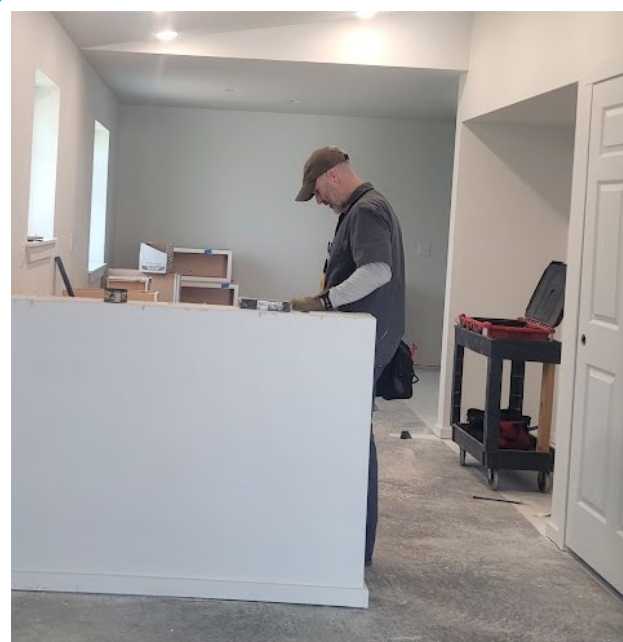

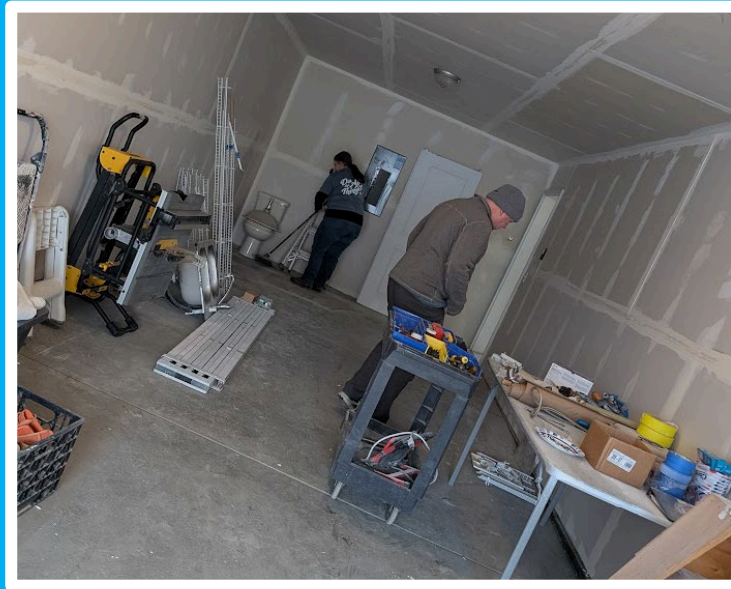
