Spokane Symphony Associates hosts this annual 13-day event, from the Tuesday following Thanksgiving through the second Sunday in December. This regional event attracts more than 100,000 attendees from Washington, Idaho, Montana, Oregon, California, and Canada.



The event features the raffle of themed and beautifully decorated trees located at the Historic Davenport Hotel and River Park Square.

Individuals and Businesses donate to create tree displays, with values of up to \$4,999 in decorations and prizes

2022 was the 40th annual Christmas Tree Elegance Event Had second highest total of \$409,323 collected over the course of the event in 2022

Previous high was 2019 – sales of \$436,707
